- 1) Institute follows zero tolerance policy to ragging. As a result of this, till date no incidence/complaint of ragging has been received.
- 2) Online anti-ragging sessions are conducted by Dean Students to explain the ill effects of ragging and punitive provisions as per Maharashtra Prohibition of Ragging Act 1999.
- 3) Online undertakings are taken from the students mentioning their commitment to stay away from the disease of ragging.
- 4) Display of boards is done at prominent locations about ragging free environment.
- 5) Establishment of Anti-Ragging Squad and visits of the Squad members to hostels during normal running of the hostels.

Meeting took the note of the same & and appreciated the efforts of the Institute for maintaining ragging free environment in the campus. Further it was resolved unanimously as follows;
